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SCHOOL BREAKFAST PROGRAM

School Breakfast Changes 2023-24 and 2024-2025 School Years

Starting September 1st, **2023*** – The 88th Texas Legislature allocated funding to cover the fee of reduced-price breakfast through the 2024-2025 school year.

* Reduced-price breakfasts served at no cost prior to September 1, 2023, will not be reimbursed by the state.



- Schools CAN use CNP funds to offset costs for serving reduced-price breakfasts.*
- Schools can also charge students up to \$.30 • per reduced price breakfast in August.
 - Must notify parents of the change if switching • to no cost meals in September.

*or for paid breakfasts.... or for reduced-price lunch.



Texas School Responsibilities

- Communicate the no-cost benefit to parents via the Eligibility and Determination letter sent to parents or other mechanism.
- Ensure POS and other methods of charging students of meals are updated to ensure reduced-price students are no longer charged.
- Enter monthly claims in TX-UNPS, including the number of reduced-price breakfasts served.
- Ensure the site application lists the amount of reimbursement (up to \$.30) that the school plans to receive per reduced-price breakfast.







Universal Breakfast

- Universal Breakfast sites operating under a universal free breakfast mandate will receive \$.30 per reducedprice breakfast claimed, even though the site application will reflect \$0 cost for reduced-price breakfasts.
- If the contracting entity would prefer to NOT receive the additional reimbursement, please fill out the Opt-Out Form found on www.SquareMeals.org/ReducedBreakfasts







Use of State Reimbursement

Reimbursement must accrue back to the nonprofit food service account and used for Program purposes, just as money received from a student would.

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To file a program discrimination complaint, a Complainant should complete a Form AD-3027, USDA Program Discrimination Complaint Form which can be obtained online at: https://www.usda.gov/sites/default/files/documents/USDA-OASCR%20P-Complaint-Form-0508-0002-508-11-28-17Fax2Mail.pdf, from any USDA office, by calling (866) 632-9992, or by writing a letter addressed to USDA. The letter must contain the complainant's name, address, telephone number, and a written description of the alleged discriminatory action in sufficient detail to inform the Assistant Secretary for Civil Rights (ASCR) about the nature and date of an alleged civil rights violation. The completed AD-3027 form or letter must be submitted to USDA by:
