Summer Rural Non-Congregate 2025!



Summary of Non-Congregate Requirements

- Site must be in rural-designated area
- 2-mile proximity required from nearest site.
- New sponsors will be evaluated based on previous CNP experience
- Sponsor must be in good standing
- Switched congregate to NC sites will be considered "new"





Available Flexibilities

- Grab-and-Go Unitized Meals (10-day max distribution)
- Parent/Guardian Pick-Up
- Home Delivery (5-day max distribution)
- Bulk Food Component Distribution (5-day max distribution)
- Hybrid Congregate/Non-Congregate Sites





Definition of "guardian":

- Legal guardian a person who has been appointed by a court or otherwise has the legal authority to make decisions relevant to the personal well-being of the child
- With written permission from a parent, an adult that is providing scheduled, informal care of the child on the day of meal service.

Unallowable:

- Adults picking up meals at a licensed child care center or day care home
- Adults supervising children as part of a formal organized activity (ex. day camp, baseball practice)



Menus **must** be provided with **any** multi-day bundle:

- If unitized, portioned food components are not packaged together to clearly identify what is required for each reimbursable meal being distributed, instructions must be provided to show how the components are to be assembled for each reimbursable meal.
- EXAMPLE: Unitized milk for the week is packaged in a separate bag from the rest of the food components - written instructions must state that only one milk should be consumed per meal.



Meal Service Times:

- Any participant **in line** by the ending time of meal service can get a meal.
- TDA developing a meal service time deviation form for inclement weather, late deliveries, or traffic delays.



Civil Rights requirements for home delivery:

- Full Non-Discrimination Statement (NDS) must be on the parental consent form.
- AJFA poster no longer required on delivery vehicles; **however...**
- In lieu of displaying the AJFA poster on vehicles, a printed NDS **must** be provided with each delivery:
 - Must be in appropriate language (https://www.fns.usda.gov/cr/fns-nondiscriminationstatement)
 - Full, **current** NDS must be used.
 - If obtaining parental consent at each delivery, NDS on parental consent form will suffice

- Clarification and best practices added to FAQs:
- Meal temperature best practices (home delivery and mobile routes)
- Pre-registration best practices
- Guidance on how TDA monitors site caps
- SSO meal service time flexibilities and overall best practices
- SFSP pre-operational visit requirements
- Hybrid site meal count reporting



Non-Congregate Materials Coming Soon!

- New NC Request Form:
 - Only sites approved last year and new sites already approved for congregate service in 2025 will be able to submit.
 - Returning sites have option to skip uploading certain procedures if no changes.
 - Distribution times will be included as a field.
- New FAQs
 - Clarified requirements
 - New flexibilities
 - Updated application instructions
- New resources
 - Application one-pager
 - Small tweaks to NC site monitoring forms

Ramadan Non-Congregate Feeding Waiver



Ramadan Waiver Overview

Allows service of non-congregate meals to students fasting during Ramadan between February 28 and March 30, 2025.

- Applies only to school districts, CACFP At-Risk sites, adult day care centers, emergency shelters, and outside-school-hours care centers in good standing
- Multi-day meal bundling and parent pick-up are **not allowed.**
- OVS in senior high schools is waived.
- Only distributed to participants who indicate verbally or in writing that they are fasting during Ramadan.
- If a participant chooses to consume a meal or snack during the day, schools or institutions may not deny a meal or snack because the participant is thought to be fasting during Ramadan.





Ramadan Waiver Overview

- Eligible CEs must submit request via online form (coming soon!) and attest to all requirements.
- Form will be available in SNP and CACFP **Download Forms in TX-UNPS**





Miscellaneous Policy Updates



Grain-Based Desserts and High-Protein Yogurt Crediting – **Public Comment Period Open**

- 2023 Proposed Rule limited grain-based desserts in the School Breakfast Program to no more than two-ounce equivalents per week (not implemented)
 - USDA now seeking input on improving and simplifying grain-based dessert requirements
- Yogurt currently there is consistent crediting for all yogurt
 - USDA now seeks input to determine if any new information warrants a change to crediting (for example, availability of new, high protein varieties)
