Claim submission for SSO and NSLP after TX-UNPS update on 09/28/2022

We appreciate your patience while we updated TX-UNPS.

Two updates were made:

- SSO meals served during July -Sept. 2022 paid at the SFSP rate.
- Severe need eligibility based on the guidance from USDA memo SP- 11-2002.

FOLLOW THE STEPS OUTLINED:

- Enter July 2022 claims immediately.
- **DO NOT** submit August 2022 claims until the week of Oct 3rd to prevent overloading the system.
- If no meals were served for July or August, **DO NOT** enter a claim for zero meals.
- Be **AWARE** of the program operated in July 2022:
 - If SSO was operated, only claim your meals under SSO.
 - If NSLP was operated, only claim your meals under NSLP.
 - Meals erroneously claimed under the wrong program will be reversed creating a debt. This debt will be payable by check or ACH, and a CAD will be required.
 - You will only be able to adjust your claim to the correct program if your one-time exception is available.

SSO only:

The path in TX-UNPS for **SSO** July 2022 – Sept. 2022 claims is TX-UNPS > <mark>SY 2021-2022</mark> > Claims > Claims-SSO

Verify meals are entered under the correct program.

If you have already entered your site claim data before 9/28/22, you must now **SUBMIT** the claim for payment. Claim must be in an <u>ACCEPTED</u> status.

Verify the reimbursement rates on the Claim Summary screen are correct:

- Lunch: \$ 4.5625
- Breakfast: \$2.6050
- Snack: \$1.0775

NSLP/SBP only:

The path in TX-UNPS for July 2022 NSLP/SBP claim is TX-UNPS > SY 2022-2023 > Claims > Claims-SNP.

Verify meals are entered under the correct program.

If you have already entered your site claim data before 9/28/22, you must *REVISE/MODIFY* <u>each</u> individual site claim to refresh the data to the accurate calculation. **SUBMIT** the claim for payment. Claim must be in an <u>ACCEPTED</u> status.

Verify the reimbursement rates on the Claim Summary screen are correct and all sites eligible for severe need are receiving the severe need rate. Rates effective 07/01/2022 are posted in TX-UNPS > Claim > Claim Rates
