

LFS Costs

Allowable:

- Direct food costs
- · Storage and transportation costs of Texas food products

Unallowable:

 Direct or indirect costs associated with developing and administering the program

Unprocessed or Minimally Processed Products

Allowable:

- Whole foods
- · Minimally processed or unprocessed foods
- Minimally processed states: whole, cut, pureed
- · Minimally processed forms: fresh, frozen, dried, canned

Unallowable:

- · Processed foods
- Baked goods
- · Pre-packaged meals
- · Ready-to-eat or prepared foods

Texas Local Products

For the purposes of this grant, to be considered an allowable purchase, the "local or regional," food item must be from Texas. TDA requires the Farmers/ Ranchers/ Producers' food to be raised, produced, aggregated, stored, processed, and distributed in the state of Texas

Texas Business Headquarters

For the purposes of this grant, to be considered an allowable purchase, the producer, supplier, and distributor headquarters must be located in Texas.

LFS Purchase Period

Funds may be used for qualifying purchases starting November 3, 2023 through March 31, 2025.
