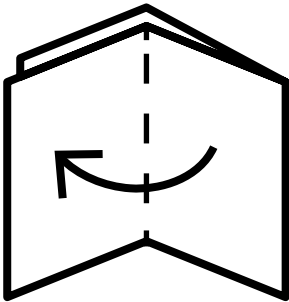
1. Hot dog fold in half.



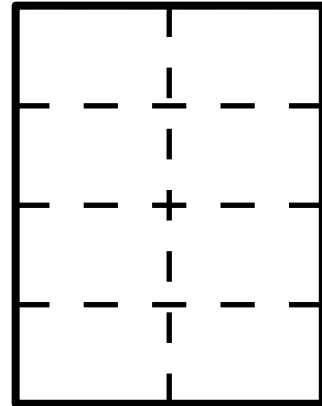
2. Hamburger fold in half.



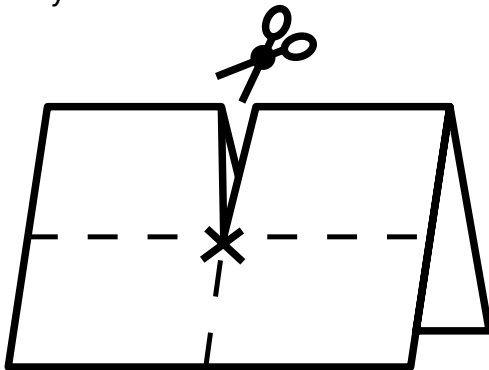
3. Hamburger fold in half, again.



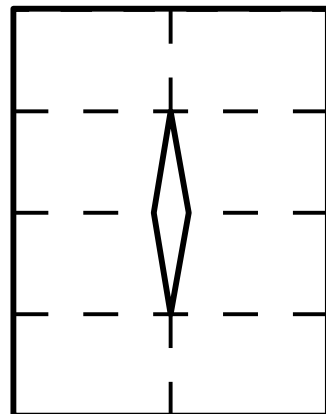
4. Unfold to reveal all 8 sections.



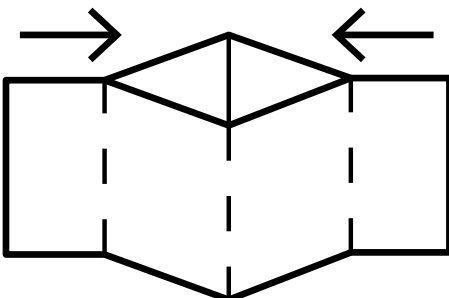
5. Hamburger fold in half, and cut halfway down the middle.
