Dear Members of the Texas Legislature:

Thank you for the opportunity to present this report on Texas schools' participation in the Seamless Summer Option (SSO) or the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP). Through these Summer Meal Programs, Texas strategically utilizes federal resources to ensure children have access to healthy meals during the summer months. State statute requires certain school districts to operate a program and the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) to report on participation and financial impact. The enclosed Summer 2023 and 2024 report outlines the financial gains and losses incurred by school districts.

Texas child nutrition professionals provide a reliable source of nutrition and support for Texas children. TDA is proud to partner with Texas schools and their child nutrition teams to identify opportunities to support access to summer meals to children across the state. 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Executive Summary

Texas Agriculture Code Sec. 12.0029 mandates that public school districts participate in a federally funded Summer Meals Program or request a waiver if 50 percent or more of their students are eligible to receive free or reduced-price meals in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP). In 2023, 764 school districts were mandated to provide summer meals. Seventy percent of those schools offered the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) or the Seamless Summer Option (SSO); the latter streamlines the summer meals process for schools already operating NSLP. In 2024, 769 school districts were mandated, of which 70 percent offered SFSP or SSO.

School districts face a variety of challenges in their efforts to offer a Summer Meals Program. Primarily, schools struggle to maintain participation in congregate meal settings during the summer months when students are otherwise not on campus. During the COVID-19 pandemic, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) waived the congregate meal service requirement. USDA authorized a Summer Non-Congregate Pilot Program for operators of SFSP and SSO in qualifying rural areas in Summer 2023. On December 29, 2023, USDA issued an interim final rule solidifying the implementation of non-congregate meal service in rural areas through the SFSP and SSO. Using the infrastructure and data gathered from the 2023 pilot program, as well as lessons learned during the pandemic, TDA established a permanent rural non-congregate feeding program and application process.

TDA continues to lead policy discussions and advocates on behalf of Texas program operators and the children that depend on the important nutrition from the Summer Meal Programs.

Charge

In 2011, the 82nd Texas Legislature passed Senate Bill 89, directing the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) to submit a biennial report regarding school district participation in the Summer Meal Programs. This requirement replaced Texas Human Resources Code, §33.024 with Texas Agriculture Code, §12.0029 under the heading SUMMER NUTRITION PROGRAM, which stated as follows:

(j) Not later than December 31 of each even-numbered year, the department shall provide to the legislature by e-mail a report that, for each year of the biennium:

(1) states the name of each school district that receives a notice under Subsection (c) and indicates whether the district:

(A) has provided or arranged for the provision of a summer nutrition program; or

(B) has not provided or arranged for the provision of a program and did not receive a waiver;

(2) identifies the funds, other than federal funds, used by school districts and the state in complying with this section; and

(3) identifies the total amount of any profit made or loss incurred through summer nutrition programs under this section.

(k) The department shall post and maintain on the department's Internet website the most recent report required by Subsection (j).

Background

In 1993, the 73rd Texas Legislature passed Texas Senate Bill 714 which amended Chapter 33 of the Human Resources Code by adding Section 33.024, Summer Food Service Program (SFSP). The amendment required school districts with 60 percent or more of their children eligible for free or reduced-price meals in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) to participate in SFSP by the summer of 1997. School districts could be granted waivers from participation annually if certain conditions stipulated in the legislation applied.

In 2011, the 82nd Texas Legislature passed Senate Bill 89 requiring public school districts in which 50 percent or more of the enrolled students are eligible to receive free or reduced-price meals in the NSLP to participate in SFSP or SSO or request a waiver from participation. This requirement replaced Texas Human Resources Code, §33.024 with Title 2 of the Texas Agriculture Code, §12.0029.

On December 29, 2023, the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) issued an interim final rule solidifying the implementation of non-congregate meal service in rural areas through the SFSP and SSO. This change leverages key findings from program operations during the Covid Pandemic and improves access to nutritious meals for children residing in rural areas where transportation is a significant barrier to access.

In January 2023, TDA established a permanent rural non-congregate feeding program that aligns with federal regulation.

Participation

In 2023, 764 school districts were subject to the requirements of the Texas Agriculture Code, §12.0029 because at least 50 percent of enrolled students were eligible for free or reduced-price meals in the NSLP. Of those 764 school districts, 533 participated in either SSO or SFSP. In 2024, 769 school districts were subject to the same requirements of Texas Agriculture Code, §12.0029. Of those 769 school districts, 537 participated in either SSO or SFSP.

Mandated school districts are required to work with TDA to remove barriers to participation, locate alternate sponsors and process waiver requests. The following table provides a comparative overview of the participation waivers requested and granted for 2023 and 2024.

Waivers

School districts were granted waivers for the following reasons:

- Enrollment includes fewer than 100 children.
- The cost of transportation is an insurmountable financial obstacle.
- School buildings or cafeterias are under renovation or construction.
- An alternate provider already sponsors a Summer Meals Program in the area, or TDA accepted that there were other extenuating circumstances.
- The school food authority is unable to operate a summer nutrition program because the projected operational expenses for the Summer Meals Program exceed the expected federal reimbursements plus one month of the school food services' three months operating expenses on hand.

Costs

School districts that had 50 percent or more students eligible for free or reduced-price meals are asked to report to TDA the total cost of operating their Summer Meals Program once concluded, as well as report any other funds (other than federal funds) that were used to pay for the operation of a Summer Meals Program.

TDA deducts the districts' self-reported information from the amount of the federal reimbursements to create the lists of profit/loss by district. TDA asks if other non-federal funds are used to operate the programs although the reporting by schools is inconsistent. Those district costs are self-reported in Appendix B (2023) and Appendix D (2024) for the districts that reported them. The most common scenario is that school nutrition programs utilize the non-profit school food service account to resolve deficits caused by operating a Summer Meal Program. If the school food service account is not sufficient, schools are required to eliminate the deficit and most commonly use district general funds. TDA did not incur costs above federal funds to comply with Texas Agriculture Code, §12.0029.
