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

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Will I be able to use TANS in multiple browsers and windows?


Yes, TANS can be used in all commonly used browsers and can be viewed in multiple windows simultaneously.
















What is the timeframe for the transition?

- Each program will start its Program Year 2026 in TANS.
- Program Year 2025 will continue to the end in TX-UNPS.
- Organizations will retain access to TX-UNPS until 12/31/2025.

Applications

- All PY25 application activity should be done in TX-UNPS.
- PY26 applications will open in TANS in April.

Claims

- PY25 claims through June 2024 should be managed in TX-UNPS.
- PY26 claims beginning July 2024 will be managed in TANS.

Compliance

- PY25 compliance reviews and CADs will be completed in TX-UNPS.
- PY26 reviews and CADs will begin in TANS.

Reporting

- Any remaining PY25 reporting requirements will be in TX-UNPS*.
- PY26 reporting requirements will be completed in TANS*.




Will TANS be used for TEFAP and CSFP?

Yes, TANS will be used for applications (aka contract agreements), claims, and compliance for Food Distribution Programs, including TEFAP, CSFP, and S/FMNP.

Training



What type of training will be available?

Training for TANS will lean heavily on self-service, on-demand formats. In-person and virtual instructor-led training will also be available on a more limited basis through your ESC Regional Offices.

Self-service training materials will be accessible via the SquareMeals TANS page and will include:

- short video tutorials
- job aids & quick guides
- user manuals

Instructor-led training sessions will be available on the TANS transition page as they are scheduled.

- classroom trainings and demonstrations
- virtual trainings and demonstrations

Will there be a user's manual we can access before implementation?

Priority is being given to short videos and job aid training materials to aid with task-focused training. More comprehensive user manuals will be released at a later date.

Will TANS have a help button?

Yes, TANS will have a Help menu in the top menu options. In this menu users will be able to change their password, report system bugs, and access user manuals.

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I'm a new director, what will I be doing in TANS? How will I make corrections to what I submit?

TANS will be used to submit and manage applications, claims, compliance documentation, reports, and complete other administrative functions for the following programs:

- School Nutrition Program (NSLP and SBP)
- Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP and DCH)
- Summer Meal Programs (SFSP and SSO)
- Fresh Fruit and Vegetables (FFVP)
- Special Milk Program (SMP)
- Food Distribution Program (TEFAP, CSFP, and S/FMNP)

ApplicationsApply to operate a program

Reports

Complete required reports throughout the program year

Claims

Submit a claim for reimbursement for meals served in that program

Compliance

Undergo an audit to validate program is being operated according to regulation





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

Program Application





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

Claims Detail










Compliance Dashboard



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

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Data Migration



Will user accounts and security permissions, including User Access Manager rights, be migrated to TANS?

Yes, TDA plans to migrate all active user accounts to TANS. These accounts will be established in TANS with security roles equivalent to the user's TX-UNPS security roles, including UAM rights. However, UAMs will be limited to two per organization, which is consistent with current security access limits in TX-UNPS.

Data Migration



How much data from previous years will be migrated over?

TDA will migrate a very limited amount of data to support a clean transition and higher quality data in TANS.

TDA only plans to migrate key foundational data including:

- user login IDs & security roles
- organization name (formerly CE name)
- organization ID (formerly CE ID)
- site name(s)
- data needed to complete calculations in program year 2026 and beyond EX: # of lunches served two years prior used for Severe Need Breakfast rate determinations in current program year. Data used for calculations may not be visible to users.

What won't be transferred?

- TDA does not plan to migrate any other applications, claims, compliance, and other data to TANS.
- Sponsors will need to populate data for program year 2026.
- Most data will rollover on future renewals.



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Data Migration



Does that mean I will need to manually enter my application data?

TDA is exploring options to provide support with this process as we recognize it is a heavy lift. However, in the first year, organizations should be prepared to enter application data. The system will be populated with organization name, organization id, site names, and site id, but the remaining application data will not be migrated from TX-UNPS to TANS.











Will TX-UNPS data be available after TANS launches? If so, how long?

TX-UNPS will remain accessible to all users through December 31, 2025. Users will be able to refer to past data during this time.











Sometimes I like to refer to a format, such as a website link or a document attachment, when uploading records for an administrative review. Will this be available for reference beyond December 31, 2025?

In TANS, compliance documents uploads may not be dictated by the formats that were used in TX-UNPS. Guidance and templates will be available for TANS documentation and uploads, so TDA does not plan to provide historical data on TX-UNPS upload formats.











What will be available after December 31, 2025?


After December 2025, TDA's IT and Data team will retain a copy of the database in accordance to records retention. This means TDA will continue to be able to pull raw data without a user interface and includes data that is entered onto a screen in TX-UNPS. It does not include document uploads or attachments.

Aside from TDA IT and Data team, all other users will not be able access the data directly after December 31, 2025. Select reports, including the Open Data Portal, will be available for historical reference.

Will you be providing a checklist of items we will need to save/download from TXUNPS for future compliance reviews prior to Dec. 31, 2025?

A checklist is not currently available. We are working internally to determine what can be provided to guide organization's historical documentation and support preparation for future compliance reviews.











It would be nice if we could access TX-UNPS for several years after the switch. Often, we need access to historical info for data comparison. There is so much valuable information within TX-UNPS, and it will take an unimaginable amount of time to manually copy to a spread sheet.

Our team is prepared to assist with meeting this need but creating reports for the entirety of TX-UNPS is an incredible level of effort that we cannot feasibly complete prior to the transition.

We need your help in identifying what is essential for you to have reference to after December 31, 2025.


