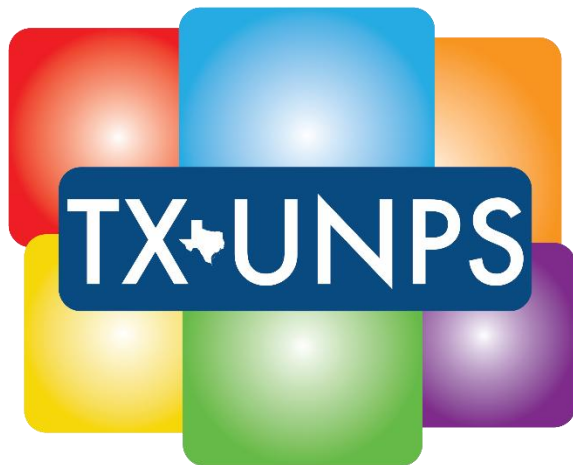

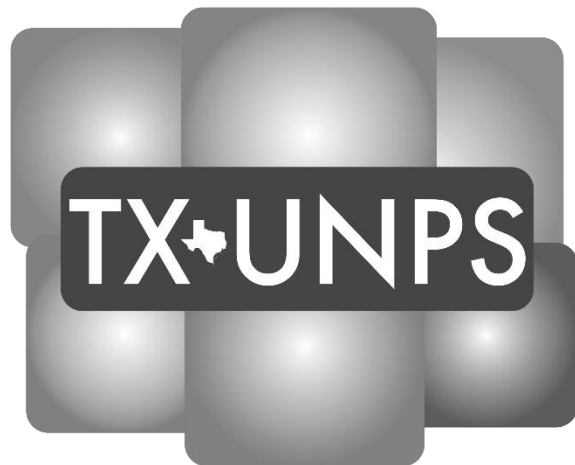

What is TANS?

The Texas Automated Nutrition System or TANS is a web-based platform designed to facilitate the administration and oversight of USDA nutrition programs. TANS will serve the same role in daily program operations that TX-UNPS has played for nearly a decade.

Sponsoring organizations will use TANS to submit program and site applications, submit claims for reimbursement, participate in compliance reviews, complete required reports, and more.

State users will play the counterpart to each of these processes through the careful review and approval of the information submitted by organizations.

What about WBSCM?

USDA's Web-Based Supply Chain Management platform or WBSCM will continue to serve the same role. All functions and processes currently handled in WBSCM as of Program Year 2025 will remain in WBSCM for the upcoming Program Year 2026 and beyond.

Texas Automated Nutrition System

Which programs are considered “FDP” in TANS?

FDP or Food Distribution Programs is the umbrella term used for:

- The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)
- Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)
- Farmers’ Market Nutrition Program (FMNP)
- Senior Farmers’ Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP)

Each of these four programs will have an independent program application, site applications, claims, and compliance reviews covering that program’s requirements only.

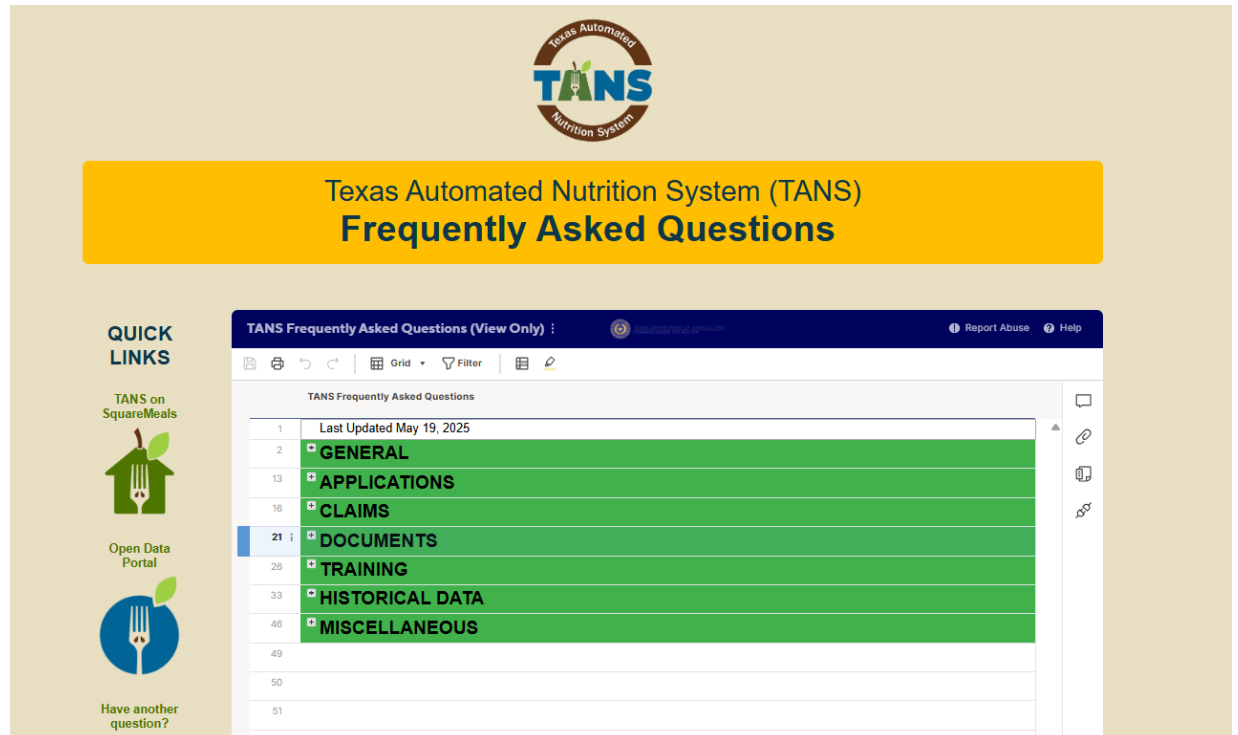
