FDP or Food Distribution Programs is the umbrella term used for:

- The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)
- Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)
- Farmers' Market Nutrition Program (FMNP)
- Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP)

Each of these four programs will have an independent program application, site applications, claims, and compliance reviews covering that program's requirements only.

 - Direct Delivery
 - Processing
- DOD Fresh
