USDA Farm to School Grant - Application Open! Schools, farmers, and eligible organizations that contribute to serving meals to kids through USDA's child nutrition programs can apply now for a USDA Farm to School Grant. In 2023, USDA will award approximately \$12 million in grants through a competitive process that provides bonus points to projects operated by and serving communities that are underserved, marginalized, or adversely affected by poverty and inequality. Interested and eligible organizations must apply by January 6, 2023. More information on the

Funding Opportunity! American Farmland Trust's (AFT) annual "Brighter Future Fund" grant opportunity is still open for applications. AFT is focused on providing resources to beginning, women and veteran farmers, as well as those historically resilient farmers identifying as socially disadvantaged in alignment with the USDA. The Brighter Future Fund grant can be used for improving farm infrastructure, accessing land, securing land tenure, addressing heirs' property, and more. A project may involve one or more individual farmers or farm families, however, only one grant can be awarded per farmer/farm family. Apply here for up to \$5,000 by November, 15th!
