How it Works

- Low-income Texans receive vouchers for fresh produce and herbs
- Vouchers are used at participating Farmers' Markets
- Vouchers = money for participating Texas farmers
- SFMNP is available in 3 metro areas, FMNP in 11 areas across Texas

Program Statistics

FMNP vouchers are worth a total of \$30/participant. In 2022, SFMNP vouchers were worth \$20 per participant, an amount that increased in 2023. Participating farmers collectively received the dollar amounts below in 2022 across 11 areas in Texas. Vouchers can be combined with SNAP/Double Up Bucks benefits to increase your income. Farmers in participating S/FMNP markets have made between \$2200 and \$7900 per month. The figures below show the total possible redemption amount in 2023 compared to past redemption amounts.

- 2022 FMNP voucher amount redeemed: \$190.992
- 2023 FMNP voucher amount available: \$850.140
- redeemed: \$85,496
